BI-NATIONAL AND COORDINATED

Such approach should be adopted with the aim to develop mutually accepted risk-mitigating measures and common health protocols to facilitate travel.



USE OF SCIENCE-BASED CRITERIA

A phased approach should be informed by science-based criteria and communicated based on easily understood requirements.



LAYERED RISK-BASED APPROACH

Both governments should adopt a layered risk-based approach when reviewing entry requirements and other travel restrictions.



ASSESS IMPACT ON COMMUNITIES

The economic impact of border closures on communities should be carefully assessed and inform the path towards the easing of border restrictions.
